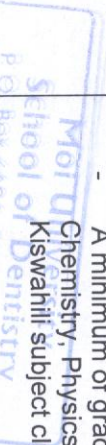

Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) 5 year programme	<p>i. For Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education holders, minimum university admission requirement is Grade C+ (C Plus) and in addition, an average of B (plain) in each of the following cluster subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Biology - Chemistry, - Mathematics or Physics and - English or Kiswahili. <p>ii. For Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education holders, a minimum of two principal passes in Biology, Chemistry and a subsidiary pass in either Mathematics or Physics.</p> <p>iii. For Diploma Holders in Medical Sciences, a minimum "O" level Division II pass or C+(plus) mean grade and a credit C+ in the cluster subjects in K.C.S.E., in addition to a three year Diploma with a minimum of a credit pass from a medical training institution recognized by the Board.</p> <p>iv. For holders of any degree in Biological Sciences or equivalent qualifications from a recognized University, subject to passing Graduate Record Examination (GRE)</p> <p>v. 'A' level British GCE system:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have an A or B in Biology and Chemistry; and either Mathematics or Physics. <p>vi.
